Chasing Chinook for Young Anglers®



Read: Read the standard rules before these instructions. We have played this version of the game with our grandkids—the youngest being age 3. They did great and had lots of fun.

Bear And Timber Trout: Remove from deck.

Dealing: Shuffle and deal the entire deck to the young anglers.

Game Play: The game follows standard play. The differences are:

Casting happens one at a time, in clock-wise order. After each cast, the young ANGLERS look for matches. Calling "FISH ON" when a match is found. However, if the young ANGLER told a fish story calling "FISH ON" when there are no matches--that ANGLER gives 1 card to the player on his left.

Everyone makes mistakes it's how we fix them that make us who we are.

End of Game: Young ANGLERS stop fishing when their FLY BOXES are empty. Each young ANGLER counts up their FISH STRINGER cards. Whoever has the most cards in their STRINGER wins.
